PREVENTING GB AV: LOBBYING

Arms control laws and policies can reduce the violence in situations of armed conflict and in "peace" time.



PREVENTING GB AV: LOBBYING

States have legal obligations to fulfill.

- -(ICCPR) guarantees women the right to life, the right to be free from torture and cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment, and the right to security of person. Rape and sexual abuse are prohibited at all times, including during armed conflict
- -The Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court recognized that acts of rape, sexual slavery... or any other form of sexual violencecan constitute a war crime and a serious violation of the Four Geneva Conventions).
- -UNSCRs 1325, 1820 and other WPS resolutions

PREVENTING SGB AV: LOBBYING

- Arms Trade Treaty signed and ratified and local legislation passed
- Number of legislation on small arms regulation crafted and enacted
- Number of loose firearms confiscated, surrendered and/or destroyed
- Number of individuals illegally possessing small arms apprehended, prosecuted and punished
- an improved system for registration of arms which includes legitimate neurological exams, seminar and orientation on HR and women's rights for gun owners




